# FACTS

## 1. What is the Lufthansa Group Hangar One?

Lufthansa Group Hangar One is the Lufthansa Group's new conference and visitor center at Frankfurt Airport. In Hangar One, the significance of Lufthansa for aviation becomes tangible. The exhibition features historic aircraft icons (Ju 52 D-AQUI and Lockheed L-1649A Super Star D-ALAN) and never-before-seen items from the company archives, alongside the diversity of the Lufthansa Group today and visions of the future

At Hangar One, Lufthansa brings people, history and the present together. It is a place for new forms of collaboration for Lufthansa Group employees, customers, business partners and aviation enthusiasts – and offers an ideal setting for events with a special appeal.

## 2. “Hangar One” – Naming & Meaning

The name sums up what the building stands for: ‘Hangar’ combines technology and tradition, while ‘One’ embodies the strength of the Lufthansa Group across all its airlines. More than 1,000 Lufthansa Group employees took part in the naming process.

## 3. Details about the building

- Architectural firm: AS+P Albert Speer + Partner
- Construction contractor: Goldbeck
- Start and completion of construction: 2024 – 2026
- Topping-out ceremony: January 2025
- Dimensions: 72 meters wide, 17.5 metres high, 53 metres deep
- Floor area: 3,800 square metres
- Sustainable and efficient energy concept: extensive green roof, photovoltaic system, geothermal heat pumps, ground collectors and a conduit system enabling electric vehicle charging points in the car park

## 4. Exhibition at Hangar One

- Exhibition agency: Atelier Brückner
- Exhibition content: At the heart of Hangar One is an interactive exhibition on Lufthansa as a pioneer and trailblazer in aviation. Visitors embark on a journey through the history of the early ‘Luft Hansa’ from 1926, via its re-establishment after the Second World War, right up to the present day. Visitors can also discover the diversity of the Lufthansa Group today and gain an insight into the future of flying.

Unique historical artifacts, multimedia content, interactive displays and two audio guides for aviation enthusiasts and young aviation pioneers bring the history, present and future of the Lufthansa Group to life.

**The exhibition is divided into three sections:**

- Take-Off – Luft Hansa from 1926 to the present day
- In Flight – The Lufthansa Group today
- New Horizons – The future of the Lufthansa Group and aviation

## 5. Icons of the Skies & Flight simulator

- **Ju 52 D-AQUI:** a stunning restored original, representing the pioneering years and the start of international scheduled services by the original Lufthansa.
- **Lockheed L-1649A Super Star D-ALAN:** brings back the long-haul feel of the 1950s (the early days of today's Lufthansa). It is accessible to the public and serves, amongst other things, as an exceptional event venue in Hangar One.

- **Diamond DA42 flight simulator:** as a special bonus for events at Hangar One.

## 6. Event & Function spaces

Hangar One features seven versatile meeting and conference rooms, as well as various event spaces, all set against a unique aviation backdrop. An ideal setting for events with a special appeal – from business functions to exclusive, private gatherings.

## 7. Catering & Shop

- **Follow-me Bar:**  
Visitors to Hangar One can enjoy a culinary break in the relaxed atmosphere of the Follow-me Bar.
- **Shop:**  
The shop offers a selection of products for aviation enthusiasts – from limited-edition collectables and design items to merchandise featuring the Ju 52 and the Lockheed Super Star. Cashless payments and payment via Miles & More are accepted. The shop is accessible only with an exhibition ticket.

## 8. Opening in summer 2026

Hangar One will open to the public in summer 2026. The exhibition will be open several days a week. Meeting and conference rooms, as well as event spaces, can be booked upon request.
